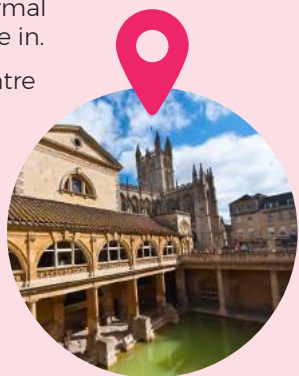

// TOUR OF CHICHESTER

Learn all about the city you are staying with a walking tour. Find out the secrets of the city followed by a great English dish- Fish and Chips.

Chichester is a cathedral city in West Sussex, in South-East England. It is the only city in West Sussex and is its county town. It has a long history as a settlement from Roman times and was important in Anglo-Saxon times. It is the seat of the Church of England Diocese of Chichester, with a 12th-century cathedral.



// OXFORD

Oxford, The City of Dreaming Spires, is famous the world over for its University and place in history. For over 800 years, it has been a home to royalty and scholars, and since the 9th century an established town, although people are known to have lived in the area for thousands of years. Nowadays, the city is a bustling cosmopolitan town. Still with its ancient University, but home also to a growing hi-tech community.



// HARRY POTTER STUDIO TOUR

See the tricks and how special and visual effects created the magic on screen. Explore the costumes and the props, and experience iconic sets like the Great Hall and Dragon Alley.

// ARUNDEL CASTLE

Arundel Castle was built in the immediate aftermath of the Norman Conquest to control a strategic portion of the Sussex coast. In the sixteenth century the castle became home to the powerful Howard family whose ancestors included the Queens Anne Boleyn and Catherine Howard. Destroyed during the Civil War, it was later rebuilt in a Gothic revival style.



// WEST WITTERING BEACH

Take a wonderful walk along West Wittering Beach. The beach has been used in many pop videos and films. Visitors visit this famous beach during summers and winters walking the dunes and enjoying the views. Followed by Fish and Chips, a great way to finish the day.

// HMS VICTORY & GUNWARF QUAYS

HMS Victory is the Royal Navy's most famous warship. Best known for her role in the Battle of Trafalgar, the Victory currently has a dual role as the Flagship of the First Sea Lord and as a living museum to the Georgian Navy.



// STONEHENGE & SALISBURY

Stonehenge is one of the wonders of the world and the best-known prehistoric monument in Europe. Explore the ancient landscape on foot and step inside the Neolithic Houses to discover the tools and objects of everyday Neolithic life. Visit the world-class exhibition and visitor centre with 250 ancient objects and come face to face with a 5,500 year-old man.
