Optional Extras

There are two optional extras available on Bucksmore Summer for an additional charge.

Active English: Two additional English classes per week (90 minutes each) in a maximum class size of three students. 'Active English' classes can focus on particular subject/grammar areas if requested.

Horse Riding: Two horse riding sessions (60 minutes each) led by expert riders, suitable for complete beginners and up to an intermediate level. Only available on Bucksmore Summer.

Students combine varied English language lessons in small classes of no more than 11 students with a well-rounded social programme that provides a fun, cultural and educational experience.

The course is available at either King Edward's School (for ages 10-13) or Plumpton College. Both sites are beautiful countryside schools situated in safe and secure environments one hour from London.
